- Chemotherapy patients

As vaccines become available for more groups of Veterans, VA care teams will reach out to eligible Veterans to schedule vaccinations. There is no need to preregister, call, or come to a facility to sign up or make an appointment. Again, Hines will reach out directly to Veterans when it is their turn.
